3. Purposes of the processing and legal basis for the processing

The Society for Interprofessionalism in Healthcare e. V. (IP-HEALTH) processes the following personal data:

- The title, first name, name, private address, date of birth, business address and field of activity, e-mail and phone numbers (business and private) are processed for the **purposes of member administration**; the legal basis for this is art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. b of the GDPR
- The bank details are processed for the purpose of **contribution administration** in the case of a SEPA Direct Debit Mandate; the legal basis for this is art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. b of the GDPR.
- Photos of members/events will be published on the association's website www.ip-health.org for the **purpose of external presentation**; the legal basis for this is art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. a GDPR.
- Advertisements are sent to members' e-mail addresses for the **purposes of the Society for Interprofessionalism in Healthcare e. V. (IP-HEALTH)'s own advertising**; the legal basis for this is art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. f GDPR.

In the course of the membership the following data will be added:

- Participation in the general meetings
- Participation in events of the Society for Interprofessionalism in Healthcare e. V. (IP-HEALTH)
- Functions and tasks within the Society for Interprofessionalism in Healthcare e. V. (IP-HEALTH)
- Application for the Award for Interprofessional Cooperation

The legal basis for this is art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. a, lit. b GDPR.

4. Transfer of personal data

Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties for purposes other than those listed above.

5. Transfer to third countries

A transfer to a third country is not envisaged.

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6. Data storage period

The personal data collected for membership purposes will be deleted from the membership administration upon resignation from the association unless we are obliged to store the data for a longer period of time in accordance with art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. c due to storage and documentation obligations under tax and commercial law, or unless you have consented to further storage in accordance with art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. a.

7. Rights of data subjects

You have the right to:

- revoke your consent to us at any time in accordance with art. 7 para. 3 GDPR; this results in an obligation for us to discontinue data processing based on this consent for the future;
- request information on the personal data processed by us in accordance with art. 15 of the GDPR; in particular, you can also request information on the purposes of processing, the category of personal data, the category of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned storage period, the existence of a right of correction, deletion, restriction of processing or objection, the existence of a right of appeal, the origin of your data, if it was not collected by us, as well as its existence in an automated decision-making process including profiling and, if applicable, significant information on its details;
- demand the correction of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us in accordance with art. 16 GDPR without delay;
- demand the deletion of your personal data stored with us in accordance with art. 17 GDPR, unless the processing is necessary to exercise the right to free expression of opinion and information to fulfil a legal obligation on grounds of public interest or to assert, exercise or defend legal claims;
- demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data in accordance with art. 18 GDPR, if you dispute the accuracy of the data, if the processing is unlawful but you refuse to delete it and we no longer require the data, but you require it for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims or if you have lodged an objection to the processing in accordance with art. 21 GDPR;
- receive your personal data that you have provided us with in a structured, common and machine-readable format in accordance with art. 20 GDPR or to request transfer to another responsible party and
- complain to a supervisory authority in accordance with art. 77 GDPR.

8. Right to object

If your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests in accordance with art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. f of the GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in accordance with art. 21 GDPR if your reasons arise from your particular situation.
